



### Letter of Interest Guidelines

AllOne Foundation will be accepting Letters of Interest [LOI] for the 2017 Fall Grant Cycle. LOI's are due no later than **4:00 p.m. on Friday, September 15, 2017.**

AllOne Foundation will be considering grants to programs and projects that are high impact, collaborative and innovative centered on the following identified impact area: **The Opioid Crisis in the Region.**

These programs and projects should coincide with our mission to make a real and substantive impact on the health and welfare of the people in Northeastern and North Central Pennsylvania by improving access, affordability and quality of healthcare.

All organizations applying to AllOne Foundation for support must first submit a Letter of Interest [LOI].

LOI's should be succinct summaries (no longer than 2 pages) of the project/program for which funds are being requested and **must** include the following information:

- Name of the Non-Profit Organization
- Amount of Request
- Name of Project/Program for which funding is being requested
- Purpose of project/program
- How will the project/program help to advance the mission of AllOne Foundation and will the program/project meet the identified impact area of the Foundation for this grant cycle?
- Are there other direct contributors either programmatic and/or funding collaborators on the project/program?
- Year of tax exempt designation under Section 501(c)(3)
- Service geography [by county] of project/program and home location of non-profit organization

Letter of Interest is to be emailed to [jcosgrove@allonefoundations.org](mailto:jcosgrove@allonefoundations.org) and received no later than **4:00 p.m. on September 15, 2017.**

All LOI's will be reviewed to determine whether the organization and project/program will be invited to submit a full proposal.

You will receive notification **on or before September 29th** - via email - of approval to submit a full proposal along with other pertinent information, due dates, proposal guidelines, etc.
